Water-based liquid wax for making decorations on candles



Decorating

Apply the paint directly from the container. To draw thin lines simply turn the fine metal nozzle (Item No. 42809). Patterns can be seen through a decorative wax sheet. After drying, cut out the wax sheet with a cutting knife and press onto the candles.



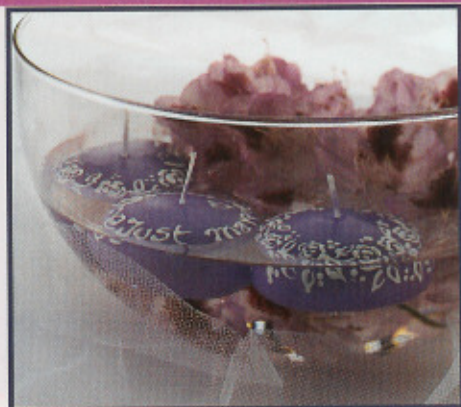
Painting

For flat paintings, spread out the paint with a paintbrush, a fingertip or a small sponge onto the candle. The paint can be thinned using "CandlePen Fluid" (Item No. 49770) if necessary. Let paint dry for about 8 hours. Close the pen after using it. Wash the paintbrush with soap and water immediately.



Stencil Making

Cut out the design from the stencil sheet and fix it onto the candle. Dab the paint on the gaps in the stencil sheet using a small plastic foam sponge. Remove the stencil and let the paint dry. Wash the stencil and sponge with soap and water.



... as Wedding Decoration

You can easily trim candles to match the wedding decoration. Paint the rose designs and texts on freehand.



... Asian style

Asian characters can be easily stencilled – too beautiful to be burned off.

... for Parties

A great idea – Using candles as name plates for birthday parties. The party guests will be nothing but pleased.
